

# Bingo

This game can be played with any of the bingo cards. Choose a level that will meet or challenge your child's numeracy knowledge.

You will need:

- 1 printed card per player
- a pair of dice
- 9 counters per player (choose 1 colour or type per player)

1. Take turns to roll either 1 or both dice.
2. Look at the dots and count them. *Some children might choose to touch the dots with their fingers, count on their hands or might be able to see and recognise the pattern of dots straight away.* If using 2 die, add both numbers together.
3. If you have the corresponding number on your board, place your counter down.
4. Fill all squares for the win!

Alternatively, this can be played without dice and children can match the numerals. Print two sets of the PDF and cut one up to make cards to pull from a pile. Take turns taking a card and if the player can match the card to one on their board, they can place the number on top. Fill all squares for the win!

\* Hint - Be creative with your counters! Go on a hunt with your child and see what can be gathered and used or repurposed. E.g. empty, flattened coffee pods, milk bottle lids, gumnuts, pebbles etc.
